### Accumulation Period

The Accumulation Period for this plan is January 1 through December 31.

### Out-of-Pocket Maximums and Deductibles

For Services that apply to the Plan Out-of-Pocket Maximum, you will not pay any more Cost Share for the rest of the Accumulation Period once you have reached the amounts listed below.

For Services that are subject to the Plan Deductible or the Drug Deductible, you must pay Charges for covered Services you receive during the Accumulation Period until you reach the deductible amounts listed below. All payments you make toward your deductibles apply to the Plan Out-of-Pocket Maximum amounts listed below.

**Durable Medical Equipment (DME)**

Base DME items as described in the <i>EOC</i> .....	10% Coinsurance (Plan Deductible doesn't apply)
Supplemental DME items up to a \$2,000 benefit limit per Accumulation Period as described in the <i>EOC</i> .....	10% Coinsurance after Plan Deductible

**Mental Health Services**

Inpatient psychiatric hospitalization .....	\$500 per admission after Plan Deductible
Outpatient mental health evaluation and treatment .....	\$30 per visit (Plan Deductible doesn't apply)

**Substance Use Disorder Treatment**

Inpatient detoxification .....	\$500 per admission after Plan Deductible

1. This plan has an embedded deductible and annual out-of-pocket maximum. Each family member will begin paying copays or coinsurance after meeting his or her individual deductible or out-of-pocket maximum (depending on the benefit), or when the family deductible or out-of-pocket maximum is satisfied. Individual family members aren't subject to cost sharing when they reach their individual out-of-pocket maximum, or when the family out-of-pocket maximum is met.
