Cleanings and examinations	 Preventive and diagnostic services are covered at 100%, with no deductible if the member is seen by a PPO network provider. Members with qualifying conditions (including pregnancy, diabetes, and cardiovascular disease) will automatically get one extra dental cleaning and examination annually from a Delta Dental PPO network provider. This won't be deducted from the member's annual maximum or apply to any dental limitations.
